Downtown Wellington Undergoes Major Upgrades

here are two organizations in ■ Wellington whose goals are to improve and promote the retail and business climate: The Wellington Main Street Program and the Wellington Area Chamber of Commerce. They are separate entities; who serve different constituents and work closely together to achieve their goals. The major difference is that Main Street serves a specific part of the business district as they relate to Main Street. The Chamber serves businesses inside and outside the Town limits.

In 2022 the Main Street Program received an "Open for Business" Grant to improve downtown business facades and beautification of Main Street (Cleveland Avenue). The total Grant of \$569,626.96 supported 11 downtown businesses including 3725 Cleveland Ave, Avuncular Bob's T-Bar Inn, Knaack of it Automotive, Leave it to Cleaver, Papa's Table, Polished Spa LLC, Soul Squared Brewing Company, The Cakery, Thistle, Wellington Auction, Wellington Grill. Each business made plans and worked for several months making the improvements with this grant money. Everyone agrees the changes were significant and have made a big difference in the appearance of Main Street.



Site Plans for New Commercial Business Developments Approved

• Kaufman Robinson, Inc. - approved site plans for an approximately 38,000 SF building for manufacturing

• Commercial Multi-tenant @ Meridian Subdivision - approved site plan for approximately 14,000 SF of restaurant and retail space

• Commercial Multi-tenant at Boxelder Commons (south of Ridley's Market) - approved site plan for approximately 12,000 SF of restaurant and retail space

• Light Industrial - approved site plan for a 10,000 square foot light industrial business in Boxelder Business Park


• Retail on Sixth Street - approved site plan for re-development of an existing site for new retail uses



CDOT/Federal American Rescue Plan funded "Building a Safer Wellington Main Street."

Additional Grants totaling \$3.5 million dollars have been awarded for Main Street improvements. These will include Highway Safety Improvements, changes to walkability to increase business access and improving flooding and drainage hazards. These projects will begin in 2024 and extend into 2026.







WELLINGTON PLANS FOR

FUTURE GROWTH and EXPANSION

T he Town of Wellington is well underway and on schedule to complete both its Fresh Water and Wastewater Treatment Facilities simultaneously by year-end 2024. In an aggressive move and with a budget expense of \$80-\$90 million, Wellington is increasing its water treatment capacity to accommodate residential and commercial population growth of roughly double what it is today. Approximately 24,000 residents will be serviced by these plant expansions. The plants also have room for further expansion later after this growth is met which is projected to be around year 2040.

The Town has updated its comprehensive plan, land use codes, zoning maps, landscape and irrigation design manuals and master plans to effectively manage the pace and direction in which Wellington grows.

PERCENTAGE OF DEMAND










